24' x 26' LOG SHELL TO BE SOLD AT AUCTION

The GLLCA is planning to have an educational workshop/fundraiser for the 4 days (May 12th to 15th, 2014) before the GLLCA Annual Conference in Seeley, Wisconsin on May 16th and 17th, 2014. The plan is to construct a 24'x26' hand-scribed log shell with a loft. The logs are expected to be 12" to 14" butts with minimum of 8" tips and kiln dried. The loft will be approximately 1/2 of the buildings length with log loft joists going across the building. One ridge pole will be included but not set up on the building.

At this point, the plan is to cut only one door into the log shell. This will maintain flexibility for the buyer as to window and other door positioning.

The building will be sold "AS IS" in the building yard of The Natural Log Homes in Seeley, Wisconsin with a live auction on Saturday, May 17th, 2014 at 1:00 p.m. Central Time. The buyer will be responsible for removing the log shell within 30 days of its completion of May 17th, 2014. This log shell could be loaded onto and stored on a 40' flatbed trailer to give buyer time to prepare their site or off loaded at their site and covered with tarps to store for an extended period of time.

Pre-bids will be accepted up 'til one week before the May 17th live auction. Minimum bid is \$18,000 with the larger size. There will be a live auction after the construction on Saturday, May 17th, 2014 at 1:00 P.M. Central Time. Payment arrangements are to have payment in full before removal of log shell. Cash or Cashier's Check acceptable.
